

Fr. Scott D. Hendrickson, SJ entered the Society of Jesus in 1997, was ordained a priest in 2008 and currently serves as a Jesuit chaplain in Regis Hall at Loyola University Chicago.

Fr. Scott is a faculty member and teaches Spanish language, literature, and culture in the department of Modern Languages and Literatures. His area of specialization is the Golden Age of Spanish literature and art. He is also involved in summer study abroad and teaches and guides a summer course along the Camino Ignaciano, a pilgrimage class that

follows the path and spiritual conversion of St. Ignatius of Loyola through his native country of Spain.

Fr. Hendrickson completed his studies at Saint Louis University, New York University, Universidad Pontificia Comillas de Madrid, and Oxford University. He has been at Loyola University Chicago since 2013.
