Each year the series will offer three speakers during the winter/spring months and another three during the fall/winter months who will focus on a variety of subjects. The series is open to the public.

2023 Winter/Spring Schedule

- Wednesday, February 8 Fr. Joe Laramie, SJ, national director of the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network, a National Eucharistic Preacher, and author of Abide in the Heart of Christ: A 10-Day Personal Retreat with St. Ignatius Loyola and Love Him Ever More: A 9-Day Personal Retreat with the Sacred Heart of Jesus will speak on the Jesuits' devotion to and promotion of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
- Wednesday, March 8 Jesuit Novices, men in their first two years of Jesuit formation preparing to make vows in the Society of Jesus will share about their vocation stories, discernment, and experience of novitiate.
- Wednesday, May 10 Rev. Chris Corbin, pastor of Trinity Episcopal Church in Oshkosh, will provide a contemporary and local perspective on feeding the hungry—one of the seven corporal works or mercy—and the food justice movement.

Driving Directions

Take Interstate 41 to Exit 113 (WI 26/N). Those driving from the north turn left (east) onto Hwy N or those driving from the south turn right (east) onto Hwy N; travel approximately 3 miles to US Highway 45. Turn right on US 45 and drive south for about 1 mile. Turn left onto Fahrnwald Road for 0.5 miles until it ends at our entrance gate. Drive through our gate onto our sacred grounds.
