The Jesuit Retreat House on Lake Winnebago (Oshkosh) is offering a new speakers' forum in 2023 called the **Lakeside Speakers Series**. Each year the series will offer three speakers during the winter/spring months and another three during the fall/winter months who will focus on a variety of subjects. **The series is open to the public.**

### 2023 Winter/Spring Schedule

- **Wednesday, February 8 – Fr. Joe Laramie, SJ**, national director of the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network, a National Eucharistic Preacher, and author of *Abide in the Heart of Christ: A 10-Day Personal Retreat with St. Ignatius Loyola* and *Love Him Ever More: A 9-Day Personal Retreat with the Sacred Heart of Jesus* will speak on the Jesuits' devotion to and promotion of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
- **Wednesday, March 8 – Jesuit Novices**, men in their first two years of Jesuit formation preparing to make vows in the Society of Jesus will share about their vocation stories, discernment, and experience of novitiate.
- **Wednesday, May 10 – Rev. Chris Corbin**, pastor of Trinity Episcopal Church in Oshkosh, will provide a contemporary and local perspective on feeding the hungry—one of the seven corporal works of mercy—and the food justice movement.

### Driving Directions

Take Interstate 41 to Exit 113 (WI 26/N). Those driving from the north turn left (east) onto Hwy N or those driving from the south turn right (east) onto Hwy N; travel approximately 3 miles to US Highway 45. Turn right on US 45 and drive south for about 1 mile. Turn left onto Fahrwald Road for 0.5 miles until it ends at our entrance gate. Drive through our gate onto our sacred grounds.
