



Fr. Brian Taber, S.J. is a native of Davenport, Iowa. Fr. Taber earned a bachelor's degree in classical / Near Eastern civilizations at Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska, where he first met the Jesuits and entered the Society in 2006. As a novice, he taught at St. Louis University High School and then earned a master's degree in philosophy at Saint Louis University in 2011. Next, Fr. Taber

was missioned to Marquette University High School in Milwaukee, where he taught history, was an assistant coach for the freshman football team and was the moderator of the student newspaper. In 2014, he was missioned to the Boston College School of Theology and Ministry, where he earned a Master of Divinity degree while serving as chaplain of the Boston College men's basketball team. He also served at Our Lady of Grace Parish in Chelsea, Massachusetts, and St. Mary of the Assumption in Revere, Massachusetts. Since ordination as a priest in 2017, Fr. Taber has been teaching Religious Studies, serving as sports chaplain and coaching at Saint Ignatius College Prep in Chicago, as well as helping at Saint Giles Catholic Parish in Oak Park, Illinois.
